

KEENE TOWNSHIP BOARD MEETING

July 09, 2019

Meeting called to order by Supervisor Robert Simpson with flag salute at 7:00 pm.

Board members present: Robert Simpson, Kara Albert, Harvey Noon, and Nancy Feuerstein + Corey

Guest present: Bradley Potter, Jeanne Vanderslot, and Dan Briggs

Motion by Corey to accept last month's minutes. Harvey seconded.

Kara gave treasurer report.

Nancy had nothing to report on.

Motion made by Corey to pay bills and seconded by Harvey. Passed.

Jeanne gave her report. She found 2 abandon houses on Scott Road. She sent information to land inspector to investigate. 2 houses on Hawley Hwy, she put fliers in their mailboxes, about mowing their lawn.

Cemetery Committee report was given by Brad Potter and Lori Larsen. They stated that the window shade is incorrect. Mulder's sent a map of the Cemetery, Lori will fill out and give the copy to Brad. Lori stated everything will be on a V-Drive, which will include record of burials, and death certificates. There will be a copy at Saranac Historical at the Depot and a copy at the Lowell Museum. The new section of the cemetery has been surveyed twice. Lori said for the procedures for the cemetery maybe the Deputy Clerk or the Treasurer could do this. Examples are sending cover letter, list of rules and contacts, such as vendors and sexton. Nancy said the board would need to come with a salary for this position. Brad put in PVC pipes in the ground to mark ~~grave~~ sites. Lori stated there are at least 150 graves, which they were unable to locate. Thinking of putting up a Memorial Wall with all their names on there. Bob Gasper put down new bases and put the stones back in place. The stones were tipped over.

Baer Mowing Service has mowed the dirt roads and they look nice.

Whites Bridge Historical Committee has ordered the timber to start rebuilding Whites Bridge. They should begin in September sometime.

Robert went to the county wide meeting at the Palmer Lodge at Bertha Brock Park. The sheriff spoke about the county jail over – crowding and the possible of putting this on the next election for a new jail.

Robert also said a resident had called the township office and wanted to rent the hall. The Board decided not to rent the hall out for anything, at this time.
