Supervisor gave report:

- 1. Trash Day was April 29, 2017. 84 trips by residents. Scrap bin was full. 5 dumpsters were there and 4.5 dumpsters were filled.
- 2.Del Linebaugh asked if we had made a decision about the mowing. We are to pay him the amount of \$2850.00 x 2 per year x 3 year contract. If either party is not happy can void contract. Fuel charge of \$2.50 per gallon. Corey made a motion to accept the agreement and seconded by Harvey. Passed.
- 3. Robert would like to start a cemetery board/committee. He will get a plan and a group together. This will be a volunteer position. He will put in Shopper's Guide, contact Lowell and Boston Historical Committees and put on the web site to get volunteers.
- 4. ½ mile of Lee Road to Sparks Road, the gravel is not holding up. John Hardy, Road Commission and Robert looked at the road. The cost is \$40,000. Maple Row might pay for half of the cost, \$20,000. Robert would like to cash in one of the township CD's to pay the township cost of \$20,00.00.
